

Mutual Non-Disclosure Agreement

A program of ATNA

Parties

This Mutual Non-Disclosure Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into between ATNA ("ATNA") and [Prospective Partner] ("Partner"), each a "Party".

Effective date

This Agreement is effective from 01 Jan 2026. It has no fixed expiry: the confidentiality obligations survive termination of the parties' relationship and remain in effect perpetually.

Confidential information

Each Party may disclose confidential information to the other. Confidential information includes, without limitation:

- Lead and client data - the identity of registered organizations, contacts, and any information about prospective or actual clients.
- Commission terms - rates, bands, negotiated commercial terms, payout amounts, and related financial information.
- Product information - non-public details of ATNA's products, technology, roadmap, and security practices.
- Marketing materials - unpublished collateral, pricing, and campaign information shared between the parties.

Obligations

- Each Party will use the other's confidential information solely to pursue and administer the partner relationship, and will not disclose it to any third party without prior written consent.
- Each Party will protect the other's confidential information with at least the same care it uses for its own, and no less than reasonable care.
- Confidential information does not include information that is or becomes public through no fault of the receiving Party, was already known without obligation of confidence, or is independently developed.
- A Party may disclose confidential information if required by law, provided it gives reasonable prior notice where permitted.
- These obligations are mutual and survive termination of the partner relationship perpetually.
